IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

Treasure Point 4-H Day Camp is open to all Camden County youth, ages 5 to 17. Youth ages 5 to 12 are campers and ages 13 to 17 are junior counselors. Residents with summer visitors may request permission for their guests to attend.

REGISTRATION is MANDATORY!!

Treasure Point 4-H Day Camp is limited to the first 70 participants registered each day. **All participants must register.** Registration is on a first come, first serve basis! All necessary forms may be picked up and returned to the North Carolina Cooperative Extension-Camden Center, Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Registration forms can also be found at <http://camden.ces.ncsu.edu/>. **REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT CAMP!**

Registration opens Wednesday, May 13, 2009. All necessary paperwork must be completed and turned in NO LATER THAN Friday May 29, 2009. A waiting list will be available.

- Proper camp clothing must be worn at all times! Cool, comfortable clothing should be worn to camp. CLOSED TOE AND CLOSED HEEL SHOES ARE REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES!! Absolutely NO flip flops, sandals, or crocs will be permitted at camp. Treasure Point 4-H Camp has a NO open toed shoe policy!! Remember this is for your child's safety. Skirts, short shorts, revealing tank tops, exposed mid-drifts, or any other inappropriate dress will NOT BE ALLOWED AT CAMP. Males must keep their pants up at their waste. Camden 4-H does follow the NC Public Schools Dress Code. Failure to comply with the dress code will result in parent notification along with being sent home to change clothes.
- Campers will need to bring a backpack or bag to keep crafts and papers in on a daily basis. Campers must keep their own personal belongings in their bag at all times in order to prevent some items from being lost. A lost and found area will be located at the school. Please keep check for items that have been misplaced. All items that remain in the Lost and Found following the end of camp will be donated to a local thrift store. **It is a good practice to write your child's name on the label on any item that they bring to camp. This will help the camp staff locate the owners of lost items.** Neither Treasure Point Camp nor Camden 4-H will be responsible for any lost or stolen property.
- Treasure Point Camp Staff will provide at least two snacks per day for each camper. However, campers are asked to bring their own bag lunch and drink Monday through Thursday. A hotdog lunch will be provided for each camper on Fridays. Please notify camp staff of any special dietary needs prior to camp. Fresh water will be made available throughout the day for campers to drink at anytime. Campers will be encouraged to drink water frequently!! Refrigerators and coolers will be available to keep lunches cool, but please remember that your child **may not have a microwave available to heat any items.**
- **Parent/Camper Sign-In and Sign-Out:** It is a policy of the Treasure Point 4-H and Youth Camp to require a parent/guardian or approved adult to sign campers in upon arrival and sign them out upon departure. A sign in log will be kept in the Camden Middle School Gymnasium lobby with the camp director(s) and staff. Please communicate with the Camp Director if someone other than the parent or guardian will be dropping off or picking up your child at camp.

CAMP RULES

- Campers should not bring jewelry, video games, toys, pets, radios, iPods, cell phones, MP3 players or magazines to camp. Items found in the camper's possession will be confiscated by the camp staff and will be given back at the end of the camp day when the parent or guardian signs them out. If items return to camp, they will be confiscated by camp staff and will be given back at the end of the camp season. Neither Treasure Point Camp nor Camden 4-H will be responsible for any lost or stolen property.
- No guns, knives, weapons (real or play) are allowed at camp. Anyone caught with a gun, knife, or any other type of weapon will be automatically dismissed from camp and will be placed in custody of the Camden County Sheriff's Office.
- All campers must respect themselves, fellow campers, junior counselors and camp staff at all times.
- Participation is expected, and will be encouraged!!
- Have Fun!! It is the camp staff's wish for each camper to have a positive experience while at camp!!

SAFETY AND FIRST AID

- ALL counselors and camp staff are certified in basic first aid and CPR. Basic first aid will be administered at camp and notification/documentation will be sent home for parent/guardians signature. If a serious injury occurs, the camp director(s) will notify the parents immediately and will call 911. If necessary, the child will be taken to the hospital. NO MEDICATION will be administered at camp unless the staff is given written permission. All medication must be given to the camp director in its original container with written directions to administer. Also, if your child does require medication on a regular basis, we have a medical release form that MUST be signed by the parent/guardian. This form must be signed in order for your child to take aspirin or any other kind of over-the-counter medications. These forms will be included in your registration packet and will be available at the NCCE, Camden County Center.

DISCIPLINE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:

- The camp staff, which includes the Summer Camp Staff, Extension Agents, Professionals, and Volunteers, has my permission to discipline my child (does not include physical contact). I understand that the Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss my child if he or she becomes a discipline problem or is disruptive to the program. Discipline includes: First offense-verbal warning, Second offense-time out, Third offense- camper will be sent home for the day; if the behavior continues and based on the severity of the offense, this will result in an automatic expulsion for the remainder of the camp program.

WEATHER

- All camp activities will resume as normal based on weather. In the case of inclement weather such as a hurricane, tornado, or nor' eastern storm, please stay tuned to DIXIE 105.7 FM and/or WAVY TV 10 for closing and cancellation information.

Parents are encouraged to share this information with their child prior to camp registration!!

I have read and understand all of the above policies, procedures, requirements, recommendations, etc. of the Treasure Point 4-H Day Camp sponsored by the NC Cooperative Extension, Camden County Center. I also understand that once I have completed and turned in all necessary registration paper work, my child will be enrolled in the Treasure Point 4-H Day Camp unless told otherwise. I also understand that there will be a waiting list of children if my child is unable to participate. Also, I understand that I must give at least 24 hours notification if my child is unable to attend a day of camp. Treasure Point 4-H Day Camp does understand if an emergency arises and/or the child is sick.
