Camden Extension Secures PPE for the Agriculture Community

Agriculture is a strong industry in Camden County, with cash receipts totaling over \$36 million dollars in 2018. Austin Brown, Camden County Extension Director and Agriculture Agent, secured various types of face masks and hand sanitizer to protect our essential farmers, farm workers, and their families. To date over 4,800 face masks and 20 gallons of hand sanitizer have been distributed to farmers and direct market farm stands.
